Safety Warnings

Damage

Table Clamp Mount






Velcro × 3 (for securing USB cable (not included) on the boom arm)

Installation


1. Fix the **table clamp mount** on the edge of the table.




2. Insert the **adjustable arm** into the table clamp mount and then tighten it.



3. Secure the **shock mount** into the other end of the adjustable arm.




 Press the clip of the shock mount and then place the ADXMIC24 microphone (not included) onto it.






NEVER extend the boom arm more than 90° after it is in a reversed position.



Installing pop filter (optional)

Install **ADXPFLT24** Pop Filter (not included) onto the Boom Arm. Turn the knob of the pop filter to secure the unit.
