Safety Warnings

Damage

- Please inspect the unit for damage after unpacking.

Temperature

Read all the safety instructions carefully before use and keep this instruction manual for future reference.

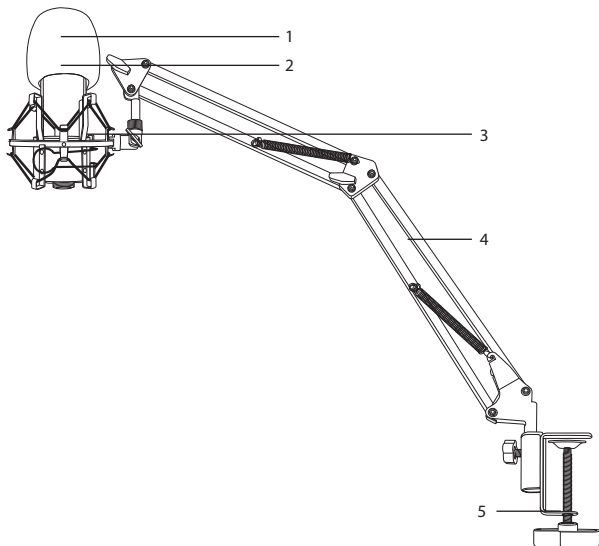
Unpacking

- USB Cable

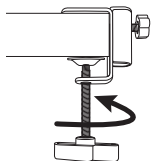

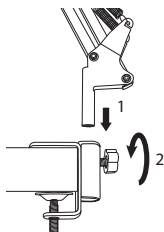
- 1. Foam Cover**

Installation

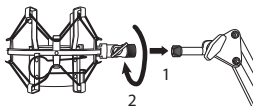
1. Fix the table clamp mount on the edge of the table.



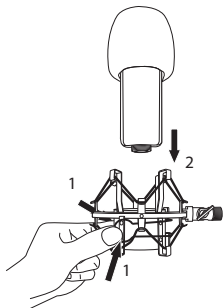
2. Insert the adjustable arm into the table clamp mount and then tighten it.



3. Secure the shock mount into the other end of the adjustable arm.

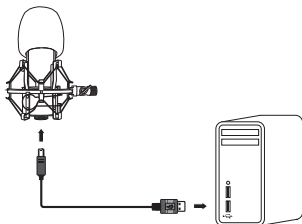


4. Press the clip of the shock mount and then place the microphone onto it.



Connections

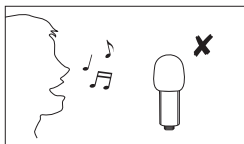
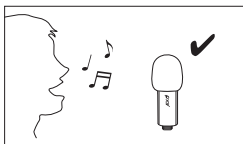
Connect the microphone to your computer with the provided USB cable.



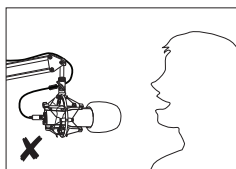
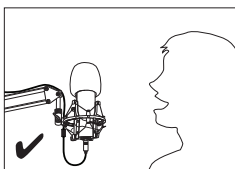
Before using the microphone, make sure that you have selected **"USB PnP Audio Device"** for sound input.

Hints and Tips

- Make sure the USB plug is fully plugged into a USB port and the computer is on or try to use a different USB port.
- If the unit is not working properly, re-insert the USB plug into the USB port.
- While using the microphone, make sure that:
 - 1) you are facing to the front of the unit;



- 2) The microphone is in a stand-straight position.
